Briefing Note

Quorn Neighbourhood Plan Advisory Committee

1. The second NPAC meeting took place on 19 June and again, it was well attended and three additional residents were welcomed but decided to await the Open event before participating. The Meeting Minutes have been circulated to all councillors however, in summary the main achievements were the:
 - a. presentation of the councils 'declaration of interest' and 'volunteering' policies
 - b. completion of a Visioning Exercise
 - c. establishment of breakout groups to consider a vision statement, a logo and a questionnaire
 - d. identification of the stakeholders, both statutory and non-statutory which is underway

2. The village Open event will take place on **Saturday 19th August 2017, 10.00am-1.00pm at the Village Hall**. This will be the opportunity to seek the people's views and interests through an engagement with the various sub-themes and to test out the emerging "vision" for Quorn's future. Articles advertising the event have been sent to the Quorn News, Quorndon, Loughborough Echo and added to the Quorndon web page (events and news) and placed on the Nextdoor Quorn site.

3. Finance – Provisional notification that the 'Awards for All Grant' application for £9750 has been successful was received on 26 June.
An invoice for £2,520.00 including VAT has been received from Yourlocale Limited. This covers the socio-economic profiling, visioning work, policy review and the consultation event. This amount is covered by the Locality grant of £5300 and was paid on 20 June. This means that subject to any unforeseen circumstances there should be no need for council funding of the Neighbourhood Plan.

4. The next meeting is set for 17 July at 7pm.
